Allen received his Bachelor's Degree in 1965 and went on to the University of Alabama to receive his Master's Degree. Allen was an educator in Alabama for 37 years spending those years at Jacksonville, Curry and Addison High Schools. During his time at Addison, he was also the head coach of the basketball team for 10 years. His 1971-72 basketball team had a 25-5 record and finished 4th in the Alabama State Tournament. This was the only Addison team to ever play in the state tournament.
