
## VINCENT LEE MEDLOCK, SR.

INCENT LEE MEDLOCK, SR. WAS BORN IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA ON APRIL 4, 1953 TO THE LATE WINSTON AND MITTIE

Medlock of Jasper, Alabama. Vince attended Walker County Training School before transferring to Walker County High School where he excelled in track, basketball, football and played the trombone in the Walker County High School marching band. In 1971, his senior year, he earned third place in the triple jump at the state track and field competition and held the school's triple jump record until one of his students broke it in 1986. He was the leading rebounder and scorer in his junior and senior years, and a member of several All-County tournament teams. As a senior he was president of the Student Affairs Committee and member of the "W" Club.



After a successful high school career, he received a scholarship to Alabama A & M University to play football. While at A & M, he suffered an injury that cut his football career short. He pursued a degree in Special Education. Upon graduation from A&M, he returned to Walker County and spent one year at Dora High School as a coach and educator. In the fall of 1976, he transferred to Walker County High School, where he spent the next 37 years serving as an educator, and helping shape the lives of many young men and women through academics and athletics. He became Walker County's first black men's basketball coach in 1998. After retiring from coaching he became active in officiating multi-sports for the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA). He was awarded the State Finals Officials Award in fast pitch softball in 2006 and named Wal-Win Official of the Year in volleyball in 2010. His other passion is bass fishing. He is a member of the Goldenrod Bass Masters Fishing Club in Birmingham. He has been a member since 1977 and is the oldest living member.

Vincent was very active in numerous organizations and committees. He gives credit for his success to his parents who encouraged him to set and attain worthy goals and a strong work ethic. Vince is a member of Greater Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church, a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., and Goldenrod Bass Masters Fishing Club. Vince lives in Jasper with his wife Christye Medlock. They have two children: Vindetta Krishawn Medlock and Vincent Lee Medlock, Jr. and his wife, Francisia who reside in Madison, Alabama.
